

Covid-19 Precautionary Measures for Chesham Bois Burial Ground

Firstly, we wish to reassure people that we will continue to lay to rest their loved ones with the same care and dignity as always. We do however wish to take all necessary precautions to prevent the risk of possible spread of the virus to families, their friends, the funeral directors and our own staff.

When Services/Interments Take Place

- Please do not attend if you feel unwell with any of the COVID-19 virus symptoms.
- **No more than 30 people allowed in the Chapel at one time. All attendees will be asked to wear face coverings** and the doors to the Chapel will remain open.
- We will be offering hand sanitizer to all attendees using the Chapel.
- Singing, chanting, or playing of instruments in the chapel that are blown are permissible. There must be 2 metres distance between the congregation and person leading the service if they are facing the congregation.
- The Eco Loo will be cleaned and sanitised following each service.
- We ask that people use their own sanitiser and hand wipes to prevent hand contact with other people; and that they take their used wipes home and dispose of as recommended.

Additional Precautions

- We recommend people self-distance themselves from others.
- We will clean and sanitise our premises, furniture and facilities regularly to reduce any risk of infection.
- Paperwork will be transferred electronically wherever possible and other documentation should remain unopened for 24 hours to minimise potential infection.
- These measures are subject to change at any time in line with Public Health and Government guidelines.
