



Chesham Bois Burial Ground

Memorial Fees from 1st July 2025

The owner/s of the Exclusive Right of Burial permit can arrange to erect a memorial headstone on graves in the formal areas after the soil has settled after an interment, (usually 12 months). There is also an option to install a memorial plaque on the wall in the Garden of Remembrance area.

Please apply to the Clerk for an application form for a Memorial Permit and refer to the Memorial Terms and Conditions document. The fees are set out below.

Category A: If the residence of the deceased or the plot owner is in the civil or ecclesiastical parish* of Chesham Bois at the date of death; or where a resident has passed away in a nursing home or hospice outside of the parish having moved from the civil parish in the previous 24 months, or longer at the Clerk's discretion. **Single fees apply**

Category B: If neither the deceased nor the plot owner is a resident of the civil or ecclesiastical Parish* of Chesham Bois. **Double fees apply**

** The ecclesiastical parish boundary extends beyond the civil parish boundary of Chesham Bois to include: Bois Moor Road (not including Moor Road); Cresswell Road; Woodley Hill; Hodds Wood Road; Millfields; cottages at the bottom of Holloway Lane; properties on the south side of Latimer Road between Holloway Lane and Bell Lane.*

Please note:

- The Parish Council must approve the wording on all memorials prior to installation and all installations must be carried out by an approved contractor.
- Having received approval of the proposed wording from the Council and paid for a Memorial Permit, applicants must arrange and pay the supplier direct for the purchase and installation of the memorial headstone, tablet or plaque.

Memorial Benches

Only Chesham Bois Parish Council is authorised to install benches in the Burial Ground. Unauthorised installations are not permitted.
